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TULSAN NOT HURT NAVY NOW STATES

Pfc. Richard B. Miller of Marine
Erroneously Listed as
Wounded Victim

WASHINGTON, Sept. 9 (AP)—The navy said tonight it had erred in reporting a Tulsa marine as having been wounded.

The marine, Pfc. Richard B. Miller, son of Paul Miller, 6915 East Virgin, had not been hurt, the navy said.

However, in a casualty list released simultaneously, another Oklahoman was reported dead while two were listed as missing.

Machinist Mate 2/c James C. Williams, son of Mrs. Claude K. Williams, Elmore City, lost his life while Boatswain's Mate 2/c Earl Rankin Johnston, son of Mrs. Irma Faye Richey, 816 North Florence place, Tulsa, and Seaman 1/c Orval Audry Spindle, son of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas B. Spindle, Coleman, were reported missing.
